Dear Parent/Carer,

Attached is the new timetable for extra-curricular clubs for the **whole of autumn term 2020**. This period will run from **Monday 14**th **September until Thursday 17**th **December and lasts for 13 weeks.**

The cost of clubs for 2020/21 are as follows:

If your child attends	Cost per week
One club per week	£3.50
Two clubs per week	£6.00
Three clubs per week	£8.00
Four clubs per week	£10.00

We appreciate that some families have more than one child at Harper Bell Seventh-day Adventist Primary School and have therefore adjusted the cost for families with more than one child.

If a family has more than one child attending	Cost per week for all additional children
One club per week	£2.00
Two clubs per week	£3.00
Three clubs per week	£4.00
Four clubs per week	£5.00

For example:

Family one – two children, with each child attending four clubs per week

Child One attends four clubs per week	£10 per week
Child Two attends four clubs per week	£5 per week
Total	£15 per week

Family two - three children, with each child attending two clubs per week

Child One attends two clubs per week	£6 per week
Child Two attends two clubs per week	£3 per week
Child Three attends two clubs per week	£3 per week
	Total £12 per week

A summary of how the clubs will work:

- All clubs will run from 3:30pm until 4:45pm, unless otherwise stated
- The cost of spring term must be paid for in full by Wednesday 30th September 2020
- Unfortunately we will not be accepting payment on a weekly basis and the cost of each club is **non-refundable**.
- Places for each club are limited and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis.

- All children who apply for a club will receive a letter confirming if they have been awarded a place or not, as well as the total cost due, on Wednesday 30th September.

COVID19 Risk Management Measures

- We are running three clubs each day.
- Each club will be allocated to one of the three teaching bubbles that are in place during the school day.
- Children will not be permitted to attend a club that is not allocated to their bubble. The three bubbles are:
 - Bubble One: Reception and Year One
 - Bubble Two: Year Two and Year Three
 - o Bubble Three: Year Four, Year Five and Year Six.
- Each bubble has been allocated an exit, from which they must be collected by their parent/guardian at 4:45pm. The exit points are as follows:
 - Bubble One: Reception and Year One the Year One classroom door
 - o Bubble Two: Year Two and Year Three the PE hall fire exit
 - Bubble Three: Year Four, Year Five and Year Six the foyer at the front of the school.
